All team buses must park at the Upper Stadium parking lot. See attached map. Team vans

may park in any available legal spot on campus.

All teams will exit through the front doors of Sojka Pavilion at the conclusion of the meet,

then walk over to their buses in Upper Smith parking lot.

At the conclusion of the meet, coaches must call their bus drivers on their cell phones. Buses will pick teams up in Upper Smith parking lot. All teams must walk to their buses.

Eligibility: Open to members of PIAA schools.

Entry Limitations: The meet will cap out at 500 athletes. Once this number of entries has been reached, the meet will be closed. It is recommended that you submit your entry form (athletes & entry times must be listed on entry form) & payment as early as possible to ensure that your team will be guaranteed a spot in the meet. Payment alone will not hold a spot for your team. Entry times can be updated up until the deadline.

Deadline for all entries & payment is 5:00pm Wednesday, December 14th. No exceptions, please contact lan if you have any issues.

Swimmers are limited in competition to no more than four (4) events per PIAA rules: (2 individual events + 2 relays, or 1 individual event + 3 relays). Each school may enter any number of athletes per event as long as they don't exceed the 4 event limit per athlete. Relays are limited to one per team. All events are timed finals.

Rules: Current PIAA Rules & Regulations shall govern the meet.

<u>Entries & Qualifying Times</u>: All competitors must have made the individual qualifying standards between the dates of July 1, 2021 – December 14, 2022. Swimmers entering with "NT" will not be accepted, times do not have to be achieved in a PIAA event.

There are no qualifying times for relays. All relay swimmers must have achieved a minimum of one "qualifying time" to enter the meet and participate on a relay. Swimmers who have not achieved a qualifying time cannot participate on relays.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$275 per school for Boy's & Girl's Swim Teams, or \$140/school for those sponsoring just one team. In the case where a school does not sponsor swimming, individual swimmers may be entered for a fee of \$25 per athlete. These individual athletes may not enter relay events unless the team fee (\$140/team) is paid. The entry fee does not include divers. Each diver must pay an entry fee of \$25.00.

<u>Entry Deadline</u>: 5:00pm Wednesday, December 14th. All entries (names & times) and fees for all swimmers and divers must be received by this time. Fees will be accepted up to warm ups at which time failure to pay result in scratching from the meet. Do not send cash. Make checks payable to Bucknell University and send to the attention of Ian Dye, Assistant Athletic Director, KLARC - Athletic Department, Bucknell University, Lewisburg, PA 17837.

Entry Procedure for Swimmers:

Entry forms must be downloaded as Hy-Tek file (to be imported to Team Manager). Competitors must enter their qualifying times for all individual events. Hy-Tek has a free version of their software here for those who need it: https://hytek.active.com/Demos/Swim Team Manager Lite.exe

Entries must be submitted as an attachment to e-mail using Hy-Tek software. E-mail entries must be submitted to ibdoo1@bucknell.edu E-mail sent to any other site will not be valid for purposes of the meet. Include with your entry file one (1) report by name. Create this report in Team Manager and save as either a PDF file or a Word for Windows file. In the body of your e-mail provide contact information (Name of coach, e-mail address, and cell phone number).

Entry Procedure for Divers:

All divers must submit entries on-line @ DiveMeets.com.

There is no charge for divers to register with DiveMeets.com. To register with dive meets go to the registration page: https://secure.meetcontrol.com/divemeets/system/register.php

Fill out all the information properly; it's very important to fill out all the information correctly. Make sure you select "No" when it says "Are you a meet director?". Under the Organization Membership select Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) and Diver. Make sure all information is correct and then click "Register" at the bottom of the page. After finalizing registration you will receive an email with your account information (Dive Meets ID number and password) that you will need to register for the invitational.

Login: To enter a meet *or* update your DiveMeets account information, Login on the left side of this screen by entering your DiveMeets ID Number and password. If you cannot remember your pass word, click where it says "Forget Your Pass Word? After you enter a meet on DiveMeets.Com, you may come back at any time (until the close of online sign ups) and change your Dive Sheet. The new dives will immediately update on DiveMeets.Com Event Sheets. https://secure.meetcontrol.com/divemeets/system/meets.php

Divers and Coaches: To change a Dive Sheet:

- That brings up the "Pool Deck page"
- Below the name of the meet you have entered click "Dive Sheets"
- Select "Update Dive Sheet" (Coaches select a diver)
- Make your dive changes & submit

Food: Concession stands will provide a full range of food & beverages during the meet.

<u>Personal Chairs</u>: <u>Personal chairs are not permitted in the facility</u>. They may <u>not</u> be brought on to the pool deck or used on the second floor of the facility.

Spectators: Spectators will enter through the front doors of Sojka Pavilion. The fee for admission to this event is \$5.00 / person. All children under the age of 10 will be admitted for free.

No noise makers on the pool deck or in the spectator area violators will be asked to leave.

Team signs and banners may be hung with permission from aquatic staff. Must use command hooks or blue painters tape, you must provide your own command hooks and blue painters tape.

<u>Timers</u>: We will need 2 timers per lane. We will waive the spectator fee for those who will time. Timers can be parents, spectators, or even swimmers that are not competing in the meet.
