VI. ENTRIES

All participating schools will be entitled to enter two relay teams for each relay event. Top 32 times taken.

Qualifying Guidelines set for the 2017-2018 season (see sheet included). All Entries must be submitted on the attached sheets and returned to Darnell Stanford by Friday, February 2, 2018, by 12:00 PM, either by mail, fax, or in person. All National Federation Rules Apply.

We will have a mandatory scratch meeting on Tuesday, February 6, 2018 At 7:00 PM at Cumberland Valley High School in the LGI Room located near the athletic office. (Enter campus light, go to the second left into parking lot and enter at lower doors – you will go down a set of stairs to get to the

doors). This meeting will be used to finalize all entries for the meet on Saturday. You may make corrections at this meeting.

No corrections after this meeting – only scratches on the day of the Meet.

It is important that you send someone – coach, Athletic Director, etc. to this meeting. All scratches and/or corrections will take place at this meeting. If your school is not present and you have corrections, they will not be made the day of the meet.

NOTE: A swimmer may be listed on the A or B relay at the time of seeding. Prior to the meet the coach must designate the swimmer's placement on either the A or B relay and this cannot be changed once the meet begins.
