On Friday, December 8th and Saturday, December 9th, 2023 the Cedar Cliff and Red Land High School will be hosting the 2nd Annual West Shore Swimming and Diving Invitational.

This meet is designed to bring amazing groups of athletes together to kick off the PIAA season of competitive Swimming and Diving. The West Shore Natatorium is a 25 yard 6 lane pool (6ft depth) with a diving well that holds two 1M spring boards (12ft depth.)

A complete Colorado timing system including six-line scoreboard and Hy-Tek Meet Manager software with Real Time results will ensure a fair and orderly meet. To follow live meet results, please use Meet Mobile.

RULES

- The National Federation Championship Rules will be followed.
- Dual confirmation on relay take offs.
- Declared false starts are allowed.
- Each school may enter an unlimited number of swimmers in individual events.
- Each school may enter a maximum of 3 relay teams per event.

• Each swimmer may enter a maximum of 4 events, two of which must be a relay (diving counts as an event). One swimmer may swim two individual and two relays OR One individual and three relays.

• Events 13 and 14 (500 yard freestyle) will be limited to 3 heats in order to keep the meet time in check. Swimmers who do not make the top 18 will be dropped. If your swimmer is cut, coaches will be notified and allowed to enter them in another individual event.

•All swimming entries files are due by Sunday, December 3rd, 2022 by 5PM to Coach Joseph Chubb

• Diving entries will be due December 6th, 2023 to Joseph Chubb

REGISTRATION FEES AND DUE DATES

Registration cost must be Received by December 4th 2023 in order to participate. Each team Fee is \$175 per team. If you are entering both boys and girls teams then the cost will be \$350.

If you are registering a diving team <u>only</u> then \$30 per diver with a cap of \$150 per team.

Early Registration Date: November 25th 2023

If you choose to register early then each team will be \$150 for a total of \$300 per team. In order to qualify for early registration you must RSVP using the questionnaire sent to the head coach or Athletic Director and the check must be mailed to the following address:

AWARDS

• Custom medals will be given to first, second, and third place in each event. Team awards will be given to the top three scoring boys and girls teams. Scoring will follow a twelve-place championship format.

MISCELLANEOUS

• Spectator Admission: Adults - \$7.00 Children/Students (With school ID) - \$5.00 Meet
